INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO RECEIVE CREDIT

In order to receive *AMA PRA Category 1 CreditTM* attendees must:

1. Attend the virtual conference on Wednesday, July 21, 2021 via ZOOM.
2. Log into “My Portal” on the TTUHSC CME website – This is a direct link to the “My Portal” <https://cmetracker.net/TTUHSC/Publisher?page=pubOpen&nc=1008789299#/myPortal>

You have been registered for this conference in the TTUHSC CME database system and you already have an account in our system.

As you log-in to “My Portal” there will be directions regarding signing-in to your account. If this is your first activity with the TTUHSC CME office, the email address on your account will be the one that you registered with for this conference. If you have ever previously attended a TTUHSC CME certified activity then you already have an account in the system. Please **DO NOT** create a new account.

If you are a TTUHSC faculty or student, it is possible that the email address on your record is the one from the TTUHSC global address book. Please contact the CME office if you need assistance in accessing your account.

3. Once logged-in, please take a few minutes to update your profile information in the system. You will find that in the “My Profile” section.
4. After updating your profile, please click on the blue Evaluation/Certificates tile. This will take you to the conference evaluation. Enter Activity Code: **35983**.
5. After completing the evaluation, you will be allowed to claim your CME credit(s) and print a certificate. Be sure to click the check box beside the session you attended and enter the amount of credit you are claiming based on your participation in that session.

Please note:

- Speaker/Presenters may not claim credit for their own presentations.
- The Office of CME reserves the right to adjust credit awarded as needed, should ineligible credit be claimed.

If you do not choose to claim CME credits and print a certificate, please complete the evaluation anyway and on the very last slide of the evaluation make this selection: **“To exit the survey and see upcoming TTUHSC CME activities”**. You will be taken to the CME website and will not receive CME credit or print a certificate.

6. **The evaluation will be available until 11:59 PM on Wednesday, August 4, 2021.** After this date, if you have not already claimed your credit, please contact the CME Office for an alternate method for claiming credit.
